SHRC Governance Review

Dear Presiding Officer

I wanted to update you that an independent Governance Review of the Scottish Human Rights Commission has now concluded.

As you are aware, earlier in 2023, the Commission made the decision to appoint an independent expert to undertake a review of its governance arrangements. This reflects a wider process of transformation to ensure the Commission is as effective as possible in its role as Scotland's National Human Rights Institution (NHRI).

I am pleased to update that the Commission has welcomed the conclusion of the independent Governance Review, and members of the Commission have accepted its recommendations, as they impact on the Commission.

They have prepared a Vision Statement which has today been published on the Commission website at www.scottishhumanrights.com, along with a summary of the Governance Review recommendations, and a link to


the full report. I am pleased to attach a copy of their Vision Statement for ease of reference.
